Step 4. Click on the link to go to Advanced Search: [basic search](#) [advanced search](#)

Step 5. : Enter composer, title of work, and a format limit of scores:

Step 6. If we own only one edition of that work, the **Full Record** entry for that score will show. Click on the **Availability** button so make sure that the score is on the shelf:

Things to Keep in Mind:

- ♪ If Cook Library owns more than one version of the score that you are looking for, you will see a list of all of the editions. Examine them and pick the one you want.
- ♪ Many of the titles of scores are in foreign languages – if you are having trouble finding a work, search by composer name (Author) and score limit, and leave the title field blank.

Collected Edition/Monuments Score Sets

There are collected edition sets (complete works) for many composers in the M2 and M3 areas of the M stacks. The individual compositions in these sets won't appear in a composer/title search, but listings for these will show multiple volumes (8 and up) in a result list. You can find these sets by searching by composer name with the word "works" as the second search term. Remember to keep your format limit to **Scores**. Sometimes you will see "werke" in a result list or catalog record; this is the German term for "works."

Select Author search → search for words in... enter word/s to search search as...

Select Scores format →

Type composer name →

Score Locations (These locations on Floor 4 – most scores can be checked out)

STACKS = scores in the regular M area

QUARTO = oversize scores that are at the beginning of the M area

FOLIO = wide or unusually sized scores that are just inside the front doors of the 4th floor in Folio case

To check out scores: Bring scores and your TU OneCard to 3rd floor Circulation Desk

Can't find a score on the shelf? Stop at the 3rd floor Reference or Circulation Desks for help
